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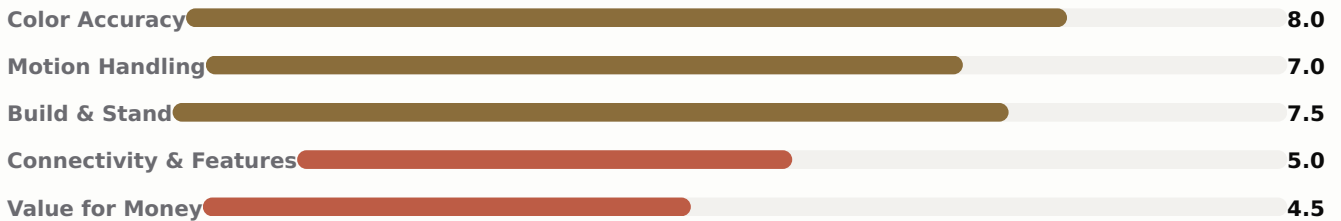

In 2026, 4K monitors have moved from luxury upgrades to standard expectations for anyone who values sharp text, accurate color, and smooth motion. Whether you are editing high-resolution video, competing in fast-paced games, or simply want more screen real estate without scaling issues, a 3840 x 2160 panel delivers four times the pixel density of Full HD. This comparison focuses on five standout **4k-monitors** available right now: three 27-inch models and two 32-inch alternatives, spanning IPS and VA panels, refresh rates from 60Hz to 120Hz, and prices from just over \$200 to roughly \$340. What to Look For in a 4K Monitor

- **Connectivity and ergonomics:** USB-C with video and power delivery is increasingly essential for laptop users. Height, tilt, pivot, and swivel adjustments prevent neck strain over long workdays.

The **Dell S2725QS** is a 27-inch 4K UHD IPS display running at 120Hz with AMD FreeSync Premium. At **\$279.99** (down from \$299.99), it sits in the sweet spot for users who want high refresh rate without paying premium USB-C prices. With 350 cd/m² brightness, a 1,500:1 contrast ratio, 99% sRGB coverage, and full height, swivel, and pivot adjustment, it covers both productivity and light gaming well.

With 732 ratings averaging 4.4 stars, it appeals to professionals who need cleaner cable management and slightly faster motion handling.

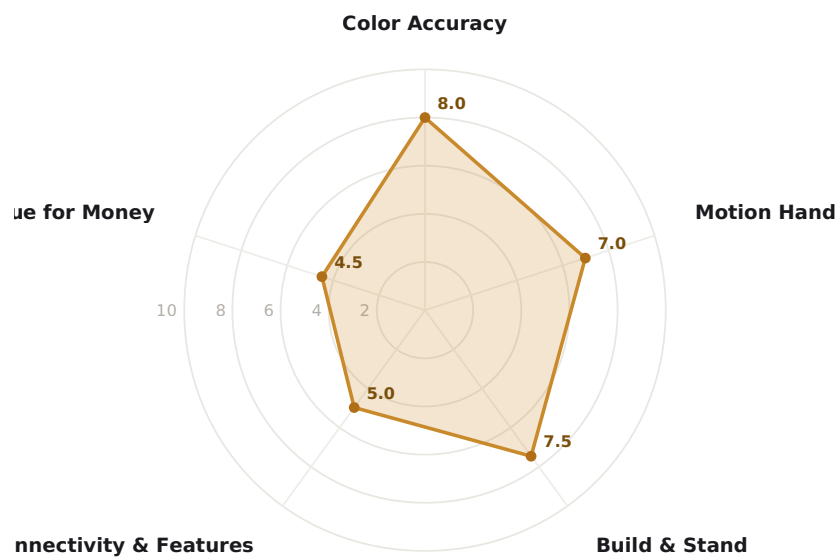
