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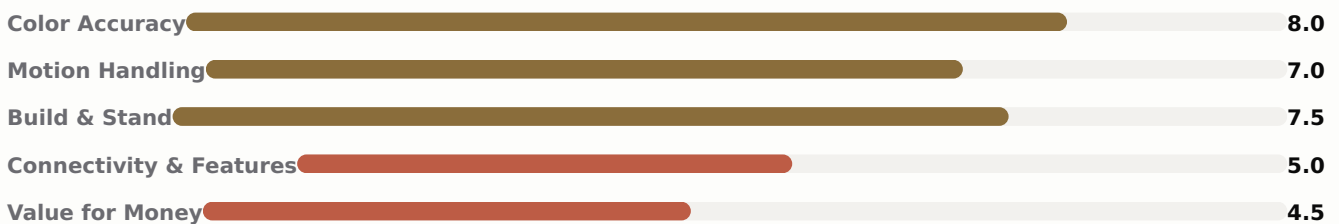

What to Look For in a 4K Monitor

- **Panel technology:** IPS gives you wide viewing angles and consistent color; VA delivers deeper blacks and higher contrast but slower response times.
- **Refresh rate:** 60 Hz is standard for office work; 120 Hz makes mouse movement and scrolling noticeably smoother and helps with casual gaming.
- **USB-C with Power Delivery:** A single cable can carry video, data, and up to 90 W charging for a laptop —critical for a clean desk setup.
- **HDR support:** DisplayHDR 400 is entry-level; it boosts brightness for HDR content but doesn't match true HDR 600/1000 performance.
- **Ergonomics:** Height, tilt, swivel, and pivot adjustments let you dial in a comfortable posture without a monitor arm.
- **Color gamut:** 99 % sRGB covers standard web/office work; 95 % DCI-P3 is better for photo/video editing.

Product Reviews

Dell 27 Monitor S2725QS



Dell 27 Monitor S2725QS

The [Dell S2725QS](#) sits at the sweet spot for most people: a 27-inch IPS panel, 4K at 120 Hz, and a fully adjustable stand for \$279.99 (down from \$299.99). It's rated 4.4 stars from 924 reviews, with 4K+ units sold in the past month—proof it's a volume seller.

Key Features

- 27" IPS, 3840×2160, 120 Hz, 5 ms GtG response
- 350 nits brightness, 1,500:1 contrast, 99 % sRGB
- AMD FreeSync Premium, anti-glare coating
- Ports: 2× HDMI 2.0, 1× DisplayPort 1.4, 1× USB-C (data only, no PD), 2× USB-A 3.2 downstream
- Height, tilt, swivel, pivot stand; VESA 100×100
- ENERGY STAR certified, 3-year Dell Advanced Exchange Service

Pros

- 120 Hz refresh at this price is rare for 4K IPS
- Excellent stand ergonomics out of the box

- Consistent color accuracy for office and light creative work
- Low input lag and FreeSync Premium for casual gaming

Cons

- USB-C port carries data only—no laptop charging
- HDR performance is minimal (no DisplayHDR certification)
- 1,500:1 contrast is typical IPS; blacks look gray in dark rooms

Bottom line: If you want a do-it-all 4K monitor with high refresh rate and great ergonomics under \$280—and you don't need USB-C charging—this is the one to beat.

Dell 27 Monitor S2725QC



Dell 27 Monitor S2725QC

The [Dell S2725QC](#) is essentially the S2725QS with a crucial upgrade: USB-C with 90 W Power Delivery. At \$315.99 (down from \$349.99), it's a \$36 premium for single-cable docking. It shares the same 4.4-star rating across 732 reviews, with 3K+ sold recently.

Key Features

- Same 27" IPS, 4K 120 Hz, 4 ms GtG, 350 nits, 99 % sRGB
- USB-C with 90 W PD, plus 2× HDMI 2.0, 1× DP 1.4, 2× USB-A 3.2
- Dell ComfortView Plus (hardware low-blue-light) and flicker-free backlight
- Identical adjustable stand and VESA mount

Pros

- 90 W USB-C PD charges most ultrabooks and MacBooks at full speed
- Same 120 Hz smoothness and color accuracy as the QS
- Built-in KVM feature lets you switch two PCs with one keyboard/mouse
- ComfortView Plus reduces blue light without yellow tint

Cons

- \$36 more than the QS for a single port upgrade
- Still no true HDR (no DisplayHDR cert)
- USB-C bandwidth shares with video; 4K 120 Hz over USB-C requires DSC

Bottom line: Pay the extra \$36 only if you'll use the 90 W USB-C charging daily. Otherwise, the S2725QS is the better value.

LG 27UP650K-W

The [LG 27UP650K-W](#) is the budget pick at \$209.00 (down from \$279.99). It's a 60 Hz IPS panel with DisplayHDR 400 and 95 % DCI-P3 coverage, earning 4.6 stars from 285 reviews. It's the only model here with factory-calibrated HDR 400 and a wider color gamut, but you lose 120 Hz and USB-C entirely.

- 27" IPS, 3840×2160, 60 Hz, 5 ms GtG
- 300 nits typical, 400 nits peak (DisplayHDR 400), 95 % DCI-P3
- 2× HDMI 2.0, 1× DisplayPort 1.4, 3.5 mm audio out
- Height, tilt, pivot stand (no swivel); VESA 100×100
- Reader Mode, Flicker Safe, OnScreen Control software

Pros

- Lowest price by \$70+ vs. the Dells
- DisplayHDR 400 and 95 % DCI-P3 are great for media consumption and light editing
- Excellent out-of-box color accuracy (factory calibrated)
- White chassis looks clean in modern setups

Cons

- 60 Hz only—noticeable if you've used 120 Hz
- No USB-C, no USB hub, no KVM
- Stand lacks swivel; lower peak brightness than Dell's 350 nits sustained
- HDR 400 is still limited (no local dimming)

Bottom line: Best bang-for-buck if you prioritize color volume and HDR support over refresh rate and connectivity. Not ideal for gaming or laptop docking.

Honorable Mentions: 32-Inch Alternatives

If you’d rather have more screen area than higher pixel density, consider these:

- **Dell S3225QS** (\$341.14): 31.5” VA panel, 4K 120 Hz, 3000:1 contrast, 300 nits, 99 % sRGB. No USB-C. Great for dark-room media and gaming; VA ghosting may bother competitive players.
- **LG 32UR500K-B** (\$271.65): 32” VA, 60 Hz, HDR10, built-in 5 W speakers, 95 % DCI-P3. Cheapest 32” 4K with HDR; same 60 Hz limitation.
