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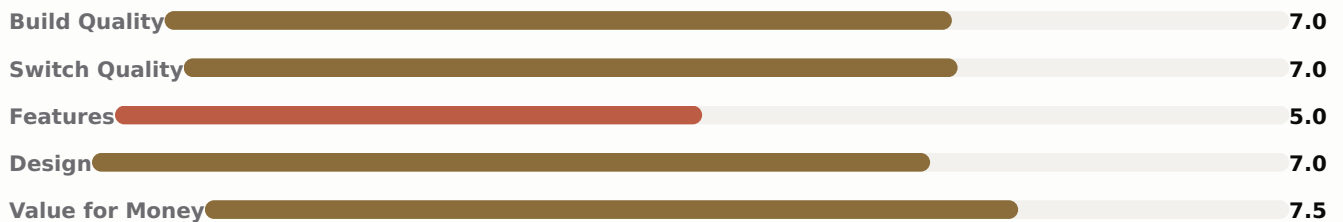

Redragon Mechanical Gaming Keyboard Wired

Intro: The cheapest board in this roundup, Redragon's entry-level wired model proves you don't need to spend big to get hot-swappable switches and PBT keycaps. With 6,700+ ratings averaging 4.3 stars and 2K+ units sold monthly, it's a proven budget workhorse.

- **Switches:** Hot-swappable Red linear switches (factory lubricated).
- **Keycaps:** Double-shot PBT – resistant to shine and legends won't fade.
- **Lighting:** 11 programmable backlit modes (single-color RGB zones, not per-key).
- **Anti-ghosting:** Full N-key rollover over USB.
- **Compatibility:** PC and Mac (via key combination).

Pros:

- Unbeatable price for hot-swap + PBT keycaps.
- Solid typing feel out of the box; Red switches are smooth and light (45 g actuation).
- Wired reliability – no latency, no charging.

Cons:

- Single-color backlighting only (no per-key RGB).
- Non-detachable USB-A cable.
- Plastic case with minimal sound dampening – can sound "pingy" without mods.
- No dedicated media keys or knob.

Bottom line: If you want a mechanical keyboard under \$30 that you can customize later, this is the 2026 baseline. Great for first-time builders, students, or a spare LAN-party board.

Redragon K668 108-Key Hot-Swap Wired RGB Gaming Keyboard - \$36.99 (was \$49.99)

Intro: Stepping up \$7 gets you per-key RGB, dedicated media shortcuts (mute, calculator, desktop), and Redragon's "cushioned noise dampening" for a creamier sound profile. At 4.5 stars from 2,230 reviews, it's a strong value pick for full-size loyalists.

- **Switches:** Hot-swappable Red linear (same socket as above).
- **Keycaps:** Double-shot PBT.
- **Lighting:** Per-key RGB with 20+ preset effects, configurable via PRO software.
- **Extras:** 4 dedicated macro/shortcut keys, sound-dampening foam, aluminum top plate.
- **Cable:** Detachable USB-C to USB-A.

Pros:

- Per-key RGB and software customization for \$37.
- Dedicated mute/calc/desktop keys – genuinely useful for productivity.
- Better acoustics out of the box thanks to foam and gasket-like mounting.
- Detachable cable improves portability.

Cons:

- Still wired-only – no wireless option.
- Software is Windows-only; Mac users lose per-key config.
- Stabilizers can rattle on spacebar/Enter without lubing.

Bottom line: The best full-size wired mechanical keyboard under \$40 in 2026. If you need a numpad, dedicated media controls, and per-key RGB without breaking \$50, buy this.

AULA F75 Pro Wireless Mechanical Keyboard - \$69.99 (was \$79.99)



AULA F75 Pro Wireless Mechanical Keyboard

Intro: AULA's 75% layout adds a programmable knob and tri-mode wireless (2.4 GHz, Bluetooth 5.0, USB-C) for \$70. With 1,690 ratings at 4.6 stars and 3K+ monthly sales, it's the hottest compact wireless board right now.

- **Layout:** 75% (84 keys) – keeps arrows and F-row, drops numpad.
- **Switches:** Pre-lubed Reaper linear switches (factory lubed, hot-swappable).
- **Keycaps:** Side-printed PBT – legends on the side for shine-through compatibility.
- **Connectivity:** Tri-mode with 4000 mAh battery (up to 200 hrs with RGB off).
- **Extras:** Aluminum knob (volume/default), gasket mount, PORON foam, PCB foam, IXPE switch pad.

Pros:

- Exceptional sound and feel stock – "thocky" without mods.
- Tri-mode wireless works seamlessly across PC, Mac, tablet, PS5, Xbox.
- Knob is programmable (volume, scroll, zoom, media).
- Side-printed PBT keycaps look clean and support shine-through RGB.

Cons:

- Software (AULA Driver) is Windows-only; Mac/Linux users rely on onboard presets.
- 75% layout takes adjustment if you're used to full-size.
- Battery life drops to ~40 hrs with RGB at max.

Bottom line: The best all-rounder under \$100 in 2026. Compact, wireless, great stock acoustics, and a useful knob – ideal for hybrid work/gaming setups.

AULA F99 Wireless Mechanical Keyboard - \$68.99 (was \$78.84)



AULA F99 Wireless Mechanical Keyboard

Intro: The F99 keeps tri-mode wireless and pre-lubed linears but stretches to a 96% layout (99 keys) – essentially a full-size keyboard compressed by removing gaps. 3,081 ratings at 4.5 stars show strong demand for this niche form factor.

- **Layout:** 96% (99 keys) – numpad + arrows + function row in tight grid.
- **Switches:** Pre-lubed linear (hot-swappable).
- **Keycaps:** PBT (top-printed).
- **Connectivity:** Tri-mode (BT5.0/2.4 GHz/USB-C), 4000 mAh battery.
- **Extras:** Gasket mount, multi-layer sound dampening, Windows/Mac keycaps included.

Pros:

- Numpad without the width – great for spreadsheets and shortcuts.
- Same excellent wireless flexibility as F75 Pro.
- Includes Mac keycap set in the box.
- Slightly cheaper than F75 Pro at time of writing.

Cons:

- Dense layout can cause accidental keypresses during transition.
- No knob – lost the F75's best productivity feature.
- Top-printed legends (not side-printed) so no shine-through on RGB.

Bottom line: Choose the F99 over the F75 Pro only if you absolutely need a numpad in a compact wireless package. Otherwise, the F75's knob and side-printed keycaps are worth the extra dollar.

Logitech MX Mechanical Wireless Illuminated Keyboard Tactile - \$157.00 (was \$179.99)

Intro: Logitech's premium productivity flagship targets multi-device professionals. At \$157 (22% off MSRP), it's 2.5× the price of the AULA boards but adds metal construction, smart illumination, and Logi Options+ ecosystem integration. 2,216 ratings average 4.2 stars.

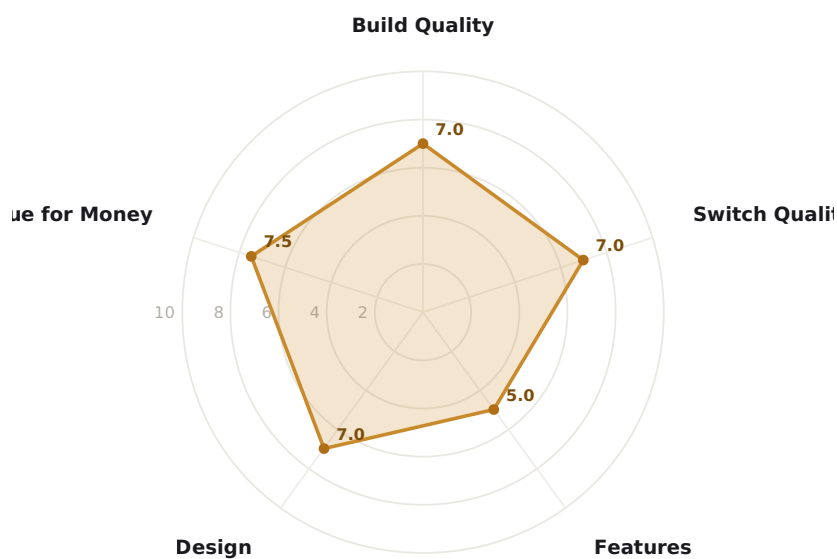
- **Switches:** Low-profile tactile (Kailh Choc V1 style) – 1.8 mm actuation, 3.2 mm travel.

- **Keycaps:** Concave spherical PBT with matte finish.
- **Connectivity:** Bluetooth (3 devices) + Logi Bolt USB receiver (included); no 2.4 GHz gaming-grade.
- **Battery:** Up to 15 days with backlight, 10 months without; USB-C charging.
- **Extras:** Aluminum top plate
