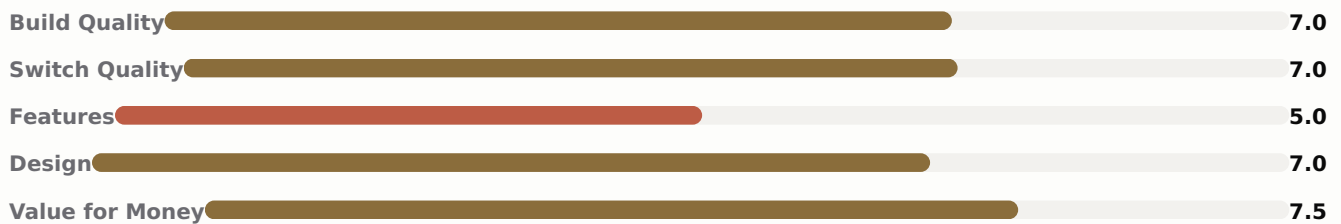

The entry-level Redragon wired model (ASIN **B0CF3VGQFL**) sells for **\$29.99** and has accumulated **6,706** ratings averaging **4.3** stars. It's a 104-key board with hot-swap Red linear switches, double-shot PBT keycaps, and 11 programmable backlight modes.

Key Features

- Hot-swap Red linear switches (factory lubed)
- Double-shot PBT keycaps – resistant to shine
- 11 RGB backlight presets + per-key customization via software
- Full anti-ghosting (N-key rollover)
- USB-C wired connection, compatible with Windows and macOS
- 2K+ units sold in the past month (Amazon)

Pros

- Exceptional value – hot-swap and PBT at under \$30
- Solid typing feel for a budget linear switch
- Software allows macro recording and lighting profiles

Cons

- No wireless option; cable is non-detachable
- Plastic case feels lightweight; no sound dampening
- Only Red switches available out of the box

Redragon K668 108-Key Hot-Swap Wired RGB Gaming Keyboard

The K668 (ASIN **B0CDWP1D58**) steps up to a full 108-key layout with dedicated media shortcuts (mute, calculator, desktop) and a cushioned noise-dampening layer for a “creamy thocky” sound. It’s priced at **\$36.99** (down from \$49.99) and holds a **4.5**-star average from **2,230** reviews.

Key Features

- Hot-swap sockets (compatible with 3-pin and 5-pin switches)
- Pre-lubed Red linear switches; optional switch packs sold separately
- Double-shot PBT keycaps, side-printed legends
- Four dedicated macro keys + media controls
- Sound-dampening foam and gasket-style mount for deeper acoustics
- Redragon PRO software for per-key RGB, macros, and firmware updates
- 1K+ units sold in the past month

Pros

- Better acoustics than the cheaper Redragon thanks to foam and gasket mount
- Extra macro/media keys improve productivity
- Hot-swap flexibility at a still-low price

Cons

- Wired only; cable is fixed
- Software UI feels dated compared to Logitech or Keychron
- Only Red switches shipped; tactile/clicky require separate purchase

Bottom line: The K668 delivers a noticeably richer typing sound and extra shortcut keys for just \$7 more than the base model—ideal for gamers who also do office work.

AULA F75 Pro Wireless Mechanical Keyboard Review



AULA F75 Pro Wireless Mechanical Keyboard

The AULA F75 Pro (ASIN **B0D14N2QZF**) is a 75% layout with a rotary knob, tri-mode connectivity (2.4 GHz, Bluetooth 5.0, USB-C), and pre-lubed Reaper linear switches. It retails for **\$69.99** (down from \$79.99) and enjoys a **4.6**-star rating from **1,690** reviewers, with **3K+** units sold recently.

Key Features

- 75% compact layout (84 keys) with aluminum rotary knob for volume/media
- Hot-swap PCB (3-pin/5-pin) – swap switches without soldering
- Pre-lubed Reaper linear switches (factory lubed for smoothness)
- Side-printed PBT keycaps (dye-sub legends)
- Tri-mode: 2.4 GHz dongle, Bluetooth 5.0 (up to 3 devices), USB-C wired
- RGB backlight with 16.8 M colors, per-key control via AULA software
- Global Recycled Standard certified chassis (30% recycled plastic)

Pros

- Wireless freedom with low-latency 2.4 GHz and multi-device Bluetooth
- Knob adds tactile media control rarely seen at this price

- Battery life ~50 hours with RGB on; drops to ~120 hours with lighting off

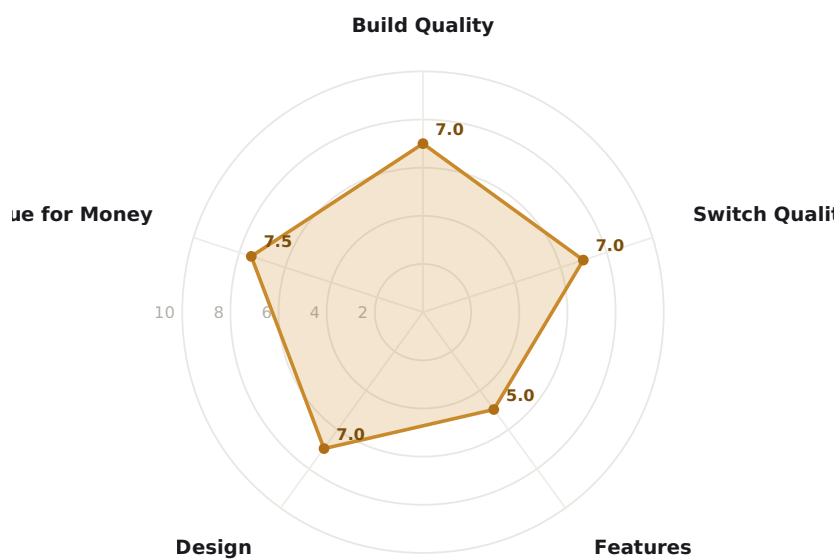
