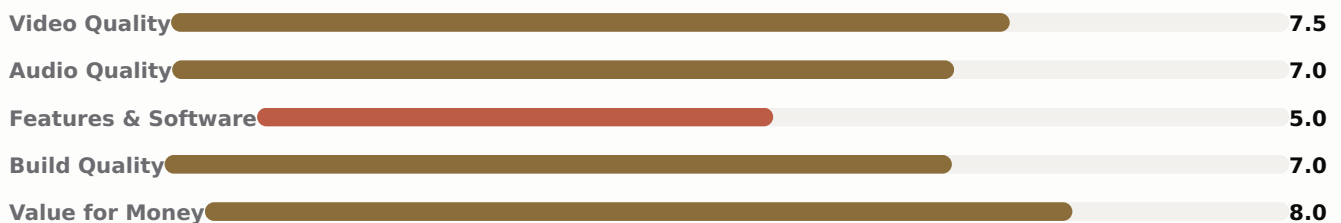

What to Look For in a Webcam

Before diving into the comparisons, here are the key factors that matter most when shopping for webcams:

- **Resolution and Frame Rate:** 1080p at 30fps is the sweet spot for most users. 720p is acceptable for casual calls but shows pixelation on larger screens.
- **Low-Light Performance:** Auto-light correction and large sensor sizes help maintain clear image quality in dim rooms.
- **Field of View (FOV):** Wider angles (90°+) are great for group calls or streaming; narrower FOVs suit solo desk setups.
- **Microphone Quality:** Built-in mics save you from buying a separate mic, but noise reduction and dual-mic setups deliver noticeably clearer audio.
- **Connectivity:** USB-A is universal, but USB-C adapters or native USB-C compatibility keeps your setup ready for new devices.
- **Privacy Features:** A physical privacy shutter or cover adds peace of mind for home-office users.
- **Compatibility:** Check that the webcam works with your preferred platforms—Zoom, Teams, Google Meet, FaceTime, or even gaming consoles like the Nintendo Switch 2.

The Logitech Brio 101 is a solid mid-range webcam designed for users who need reliable 1080p quality for both streaming and professional meetings. It features auto-light correction that adjusts exposure on the fly, a built-in microphone, and a physical privacy shutter for when the camera isn't in use. It connects via USB-A and is compatible with Teams, Google Meet, Zoom, and other major platforms. It also carries ECOLOGO certification, meaning it meets environmental standards for energy efficiency and reduced hazardous materials.

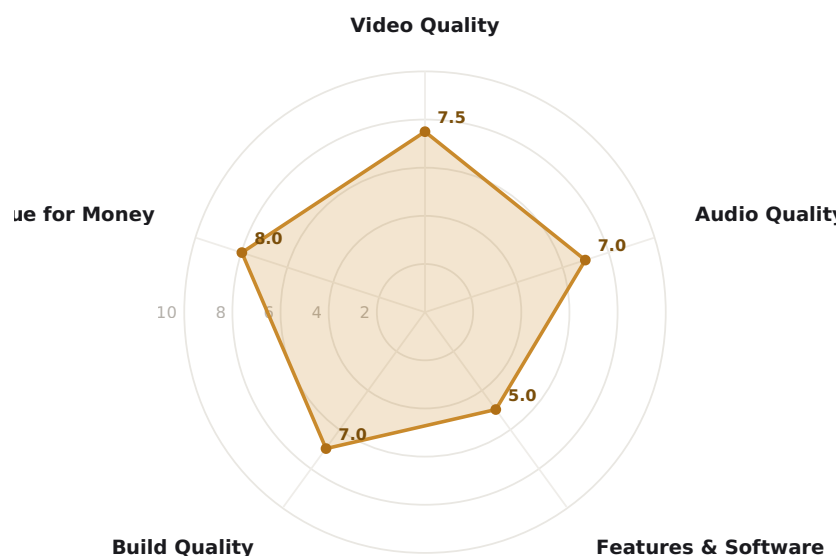
