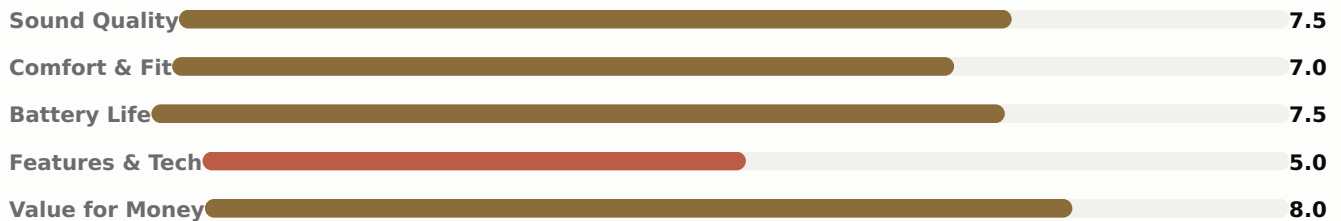

Understanding Wireless Headphones Technology

- **Active Noise Cancelling (ANC)** – uses outward- and inward-facing microphones to generate anti-phase sound waves, reducing ambient noise. Hybrid ANC combines both feed-forward and feedback mics for broader coverage.
- **Transparency/Awareness Mode** – lets external sound pass through so you stay aware of your surroundings without removing the headphones.
- **Battery Management** – advertised playtime often assumes ANC off; real-world usage with ANC enabled can drop 20-30 %. Look for quick-charge specs (e.g., 10 min → 2 h).
- **Audio Codecs** – SBC is standard; AAC (Apple/iOS) and aptX/Android improve fidelity. Hi-Res audio support indicates capability to handle >48 kHz/24-bit streams, though source material matters.
- **Build & Comfort** – over-ear designs with memory-foam or protein leather ear cups distribute pressure; in-ear models benefit from multiple tip sizes and IPX ratings for sweat/water resistance.

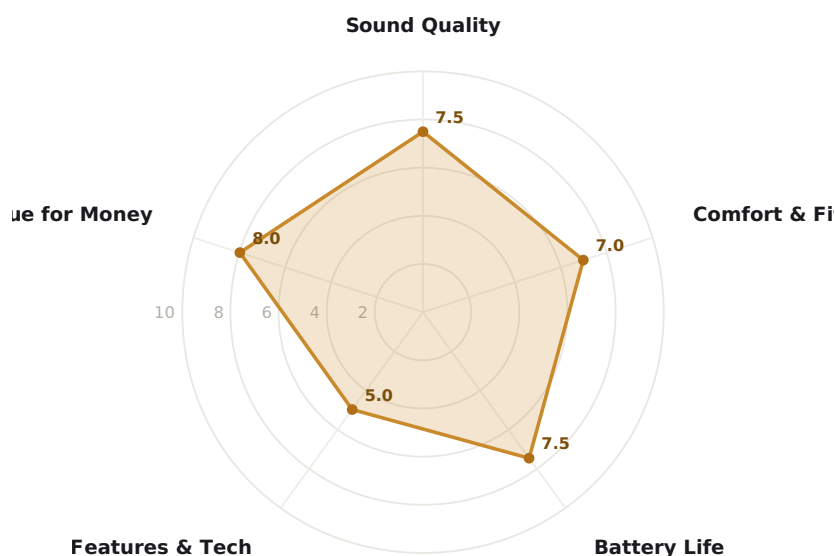
